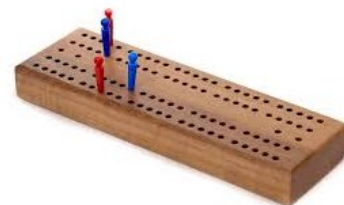

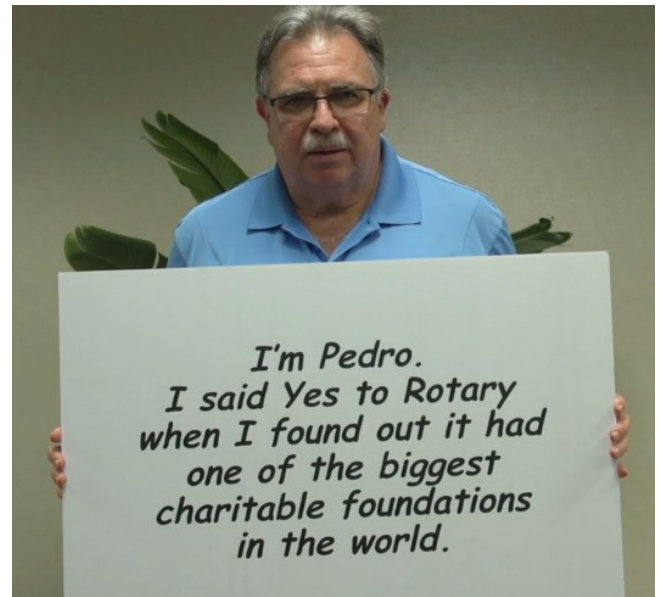
2018 PETS: President Elect Training Seminar

RCGPC was hosted by Sherry Noska, general manager of the Cobblestone Inn of Stevens Point on Friday, March 16. She gave us a nice history of Cobblestone coming to Point, her personal journey in returning to her home town, and a nice tour of the new (and lovely) facility. This is one of only two Cobblestone properties that have a Wissota Chophouse inhouse. Business has been brisk, exceeding their expectations. They have had many corporate bookings, with Sentry insurance and the UWSP construction project leading the way. Most of their bookings are handled through Expedia, with room rates fluctuating generally between \$99 and \$135.
