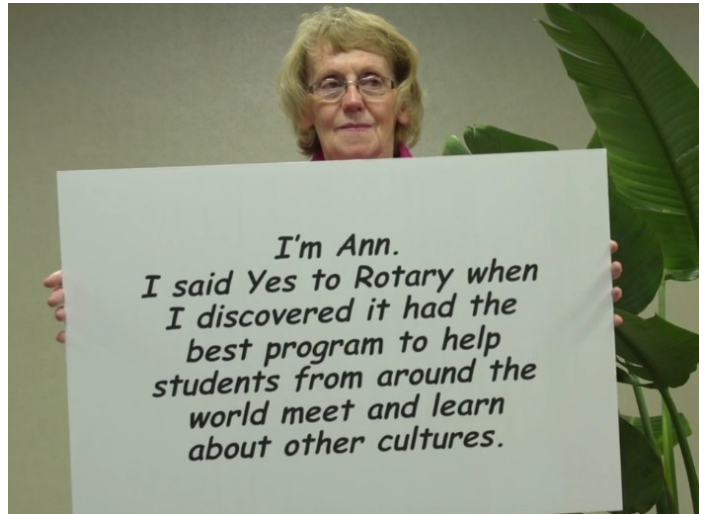
2018 PETS: President Elect Training Seminar
